PARAMEDIC STAFF

21 With effect from 1 April 2005 paramedic staff on national rates in NHS trusts required to use paramedical skills shall be paid allowances at the following rates:

Full paramedical skills to IHCD standards (and holding a current IHCD certificate)	1,026
Skills in intubation, infusion and defibrillation only	739
Skills in intubation and infusion only	437
Skills in defibrillation only	302

These allowances shall count for all purposes including calculation of payment for overtime worked.
