SCHEDULE of EXTERNALLY FUNDED COURSES April 2017 – March 2018

Introduction

1. The Army Medical Services (AMS) Reserve Schedule of External Courses for training year (TY) 17/18 outlines training courses supplied by external providers to support the Defence Plan, aid personal military training development and beneficial to a Reservists civilian employment.
2. The training must be agreed as per the DHET Statement of Training Task (AMS Reserves SOTT(E)) for external courses.
3. The courses are open to all AMS Reserve Medical, Nursing, Dental and Allied Healthcare personnel.

Applications

5. All applications for training courses are to be submitted to the Deanery via the Training Major (TM) or sS equivalent and emailed to: [SG HDT-DHET-ExtEd Mailbox \(MULTIUSER\)](#) using the [External Course Application form \(MOD Form 1797\)](#) or [DMS Group](#)

[Application for Funding of Medical Education and Training](#) together with **all** other necessary documentation, declaration form, supporting comments and required signatories¹. Incomplete applications will not be processed and will be returned to the unit.

6. All Level 6 (L6) (or higher) courses or courses costing in excess of £1000 application forms must be accompanied by an up-to-date Military Curriculum Vitae (CV) and relevant course information/costs.
7. All personnel applying must be able to meet the university entry requirements for which they are applying.
8. Fully completed applications must reach the Deanery with least 4 weeks before the start of the course or earlier to allow sufficient time for review and processing. Applications for L6 courses (or higher) and those costing over £1000 must take into account the additional time required for single service selection and scrutiny board process (sSSB)².
9. For courses that run for longer than one academic year funding will need to be applied for annually using the [External Course Application form \(MOD Form 1797\)](#) along with evidence of preceding years completion. Email too: [SG HDT-DHET-ExtEd Mailbox \(MULTIUSER\)](#). Follow on funding applications will be considered during the quarterly scrutiny boards.

Boarding Process

10. External Education Training (EET) funding scrutiny board will scrutinise all applications lower than L6 and costing less than £1000 in accordance with JSP 950 Lft 4-6-3 on a weekly/fortnightly basis.
11. All L6 (or higher) courses and those costing more than £1000 in accordance with JSP 950 Lft 4-6-3 will be scrutinised at the AMS sSSB held quarterly.

Funding Notification

12. The Deanery will inform applicants and their Unit TM/Training Officer (TO) or equivalent if they have been successful or unsuccessful and provide a Letter of Authorisation (LA) and Unique Reference Number (URN).

13. Applicants/units who have not received a LA/URN and who make a commitment to an educational and training provider prior to receiving Deanery authorisation will be personally liable for any fees and charge resulting from the commitment.

Withdrawal from Training

14. Applicants who must cancel or cannot attend the authorised courses, in full or part, are to inform their Unit CoC, SO1 Med Res, the Deanery, and the Training Provider (inc finance department/bursar) with as much notice as possible. Failure to inform all of the above may result in applicants being personally liable for any fees and charges resulting from cancellation and could lead to disciplinary action.

Mandatory Training Days and Travel and Subsistence

15. MTDs/T&S are a Units responsibility and will need to be discussed and resourced via the CoC prior to submission of application.

Completion of Course

16. Applicants are to inform EETS via their CoC on completion of course and update JPA as appropriate.

Notes

- Funding for external training is heavily scrutinised to ensure good value for money for the Defence and the tax payer. On that basis, in order, to assist in a favourable outcome you **must** make sure:
 - The application process is completed correctly including supporting comments/ documents from the CoC explaining how the training will meet the Defence plan/training requirement for role.
 - Ensure the Training Advisor (TA) comments are included and the application has been authorised by the Commanding Officer/TM.
 - Unit submission with appropriate time given to process and submit to scrutiny board (if relevant).
