

## Enhanced and additional services supported by NHS Employers 2017/18

### Vaccination and immunisation programmes supported by NHS Employers

NHS Employers (on behalf of NHS England) negotiated the programmes in table 1 with the BMA's General Practitioners Committee (GPC) and as such provide implementation support to commissioners.

| Pertussis for pregnant women                     | Human papilloma virus (HPV) completing dose (booster)  |

| Seasonal influenza and pneumococcal <sup>1</sup> | Meningitis C (3 month dose - removed from 1 July 2016) |
