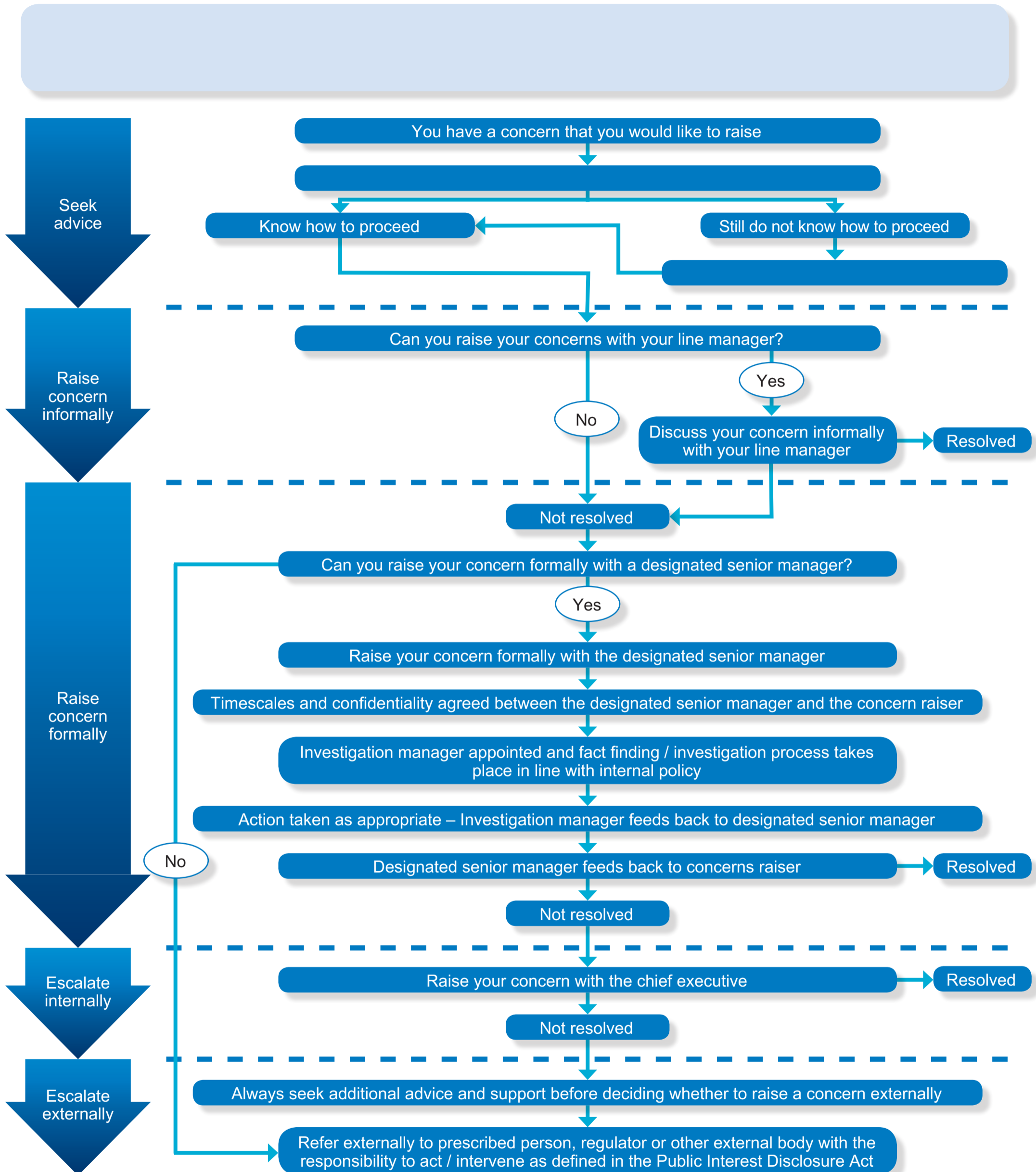


Model process flowchart for raising concerns

Raising a public interest (whistleblowing) concern.

A public interest concern may include where:

- someone's health and / or safety has been put in danger because of an action or inaction;
- damage has been caused to the environment;
- a criminal offence has been committed;
- an employer fails to obey the law (such as not having appropriate insurance);
- a malpractice or wrong-doing has been covered up.
