

AWARD: Travel and logistics

The health and care system accounts for a significant proportion of road traffic in England - up to one in 20 of all road miles are health related. Air pollution in the UK is a contributory factor to in excess of 40,000 deaths a year. Small changes in the way we move people and goods can have a big impact on health.

This award will showcase an organisation that has delivered effective projects or programmes to help improve health through travel and logistics.

The organisation must be able to evidence quantitative improvements and may also have set a local target for reducing travel and logistics emissions. Entries should identify how they have engaged staff, visitors and patients around healthier travel habits and should be able to demonstrate reduced traffic and/or associated air quality impacts in its local area and local populace health. This could be done using the Sustainable Development Unit's Health Outcomes of Travel Tool.

The organisation should also be able to demonstrate that they have considered ways to engage and work with their supply chain and local partners and stakeholders, such as local authorities and universities.

As the judges mark your entry they will be looking for:

- A clear description of why your organisation/project is exemplary
- Any evidence of environmental, social and/or local economic benefits
- Lasting and replicable change
- Details of any financial savings
- Benefits to staff, patient or population health
- Challenges the organisation has had to overcome.
